### **Appointment Information:**

- <u>From now until further notice</u>, all scheduled monitoring and treatment appointments will be take place via a telehealth appointment over the <u>PHONE</u>. We would love to see you, but **please do not come to the clinic for your appointment.**
- Your telehealth appointment will take place on the day of your scheduled appointment. A staff member will contact you by phone within 30 minutes to 1½ hours of your appointment time. We will do our best to contact you by phone as close to your appointment time as possible.
- We will schedule you to complete the in-person parts of the exam (i.e. blood work, spirometry, physical exam, etc.) at a later date.
- You do <u>NOT</u> need to reschedule your appointment <u>UNLESS</u> you prefer to reschedule your exam in its <u>ENTIRETY</u>. If you would like reschedule your entire exam, please contact us at 848-445-0123, option 1 then 4.
- To prepare for the mental health portion of your exam, you will receive an email from wtchp-help@eohsi.rutgers.edu. Please be sure to check your spam folder.
- Please **<u>DO NOT</u>** submit any of your documents (i.e. medical records, patient packets, bills, etc.) to our office in person.
- If you need to submit medical records or any other documents to us, please do so by fax to 732-445-0127, by email to wtchp-help@eohsi.rutgers.edu or by mail to EOHSI/WTCHP 170 Frelinghuysen Rd. Piscataway, NJ 08854. Please put Attn: Medical Records <u>OR</u> Attn: To (the appropriate person).
