Biographical Summary †

Daniel A. Bakston, MD, MPH, MBA, FACOEM, DABPM, C-MRO, C-NRCME is the program director for the University of Illinois Occupational and Environmental Medicine Residency program. Dr. Bakston is board certified in Occupational and Environmental Medicine and a diplomate of the American Board of Preventive Medicine, he is a certified medical review officer, a certified examiner for the National Registry of Commercial Medical Drivers and a Fellow of the American College of Occupational and Environmental Medicine. His primary appointment is in the Environmental and Occupational Health Sciences Division of the UIC School of Public Health as a Clinical Assistant Professor. He holds an appointment at Rush University in General Internal Medicine and is the principle provider in the Rush Medical Center Employee and Corporate Health Clinic. He is an Attending Physician in the Occupational Medicine Program in the Community Health System in Indiana as well as on staff at Munster Community Hospital and St. Catherine Hospital. Additionally, he has held a faculty appointment in the Division of Emergency Medicine at the University of Chicago as a Clinical Associate where he was the former Medical Director of Occupational Medicine. He was also the Medical Director at University of Chicago – Ingalls Memorial Hospital.

In the course of his work Dr. Bakston frequently visits employers around Chicago and also lectures to employers on Occupational Injury and prevention. He is a reviewer for the Journal of Occupational and Environmental Medicine and has given lectures in multi-disciplinary seminars at the school of Public Health, the local Medical Director's Club, and regional conferences. He has collaborated with Dr. Susan Buchanan on an ongoing Healthy Homes (green renovations) research project at UIC. Dr. Bakston is the Past President and on the board of the Association of Occupational and Environmental Clinics and a councilor of the Chicago Medical Society. Dr. Bakston holds a graduate certificate in HealthCare Administration and completed his Master in Public Health and Business Administration.
